**DECREE OF DISSOLUTION\***

This matter comes on for hearing before the Supreme Judge of the Highest Court of the Kingdom of God on the petition of The People of God seeking a Decree of Dissolution from The Principality of Mammon, the Defendant in this matter.

The Court finds:

1. The Plaintiff's assertions are fully substantiated:
  - a. That this partnership was entered into by the Plaintiff based on lies and deceit by the Defendant, and
  - b. That Plaintiff relied on fraudulent inducements and enticements by the Defendant, which Defendant had neither the intention or ability to deliver, and
  - c. That Plaintiff acknowledges that this principality is not to be feared or tolerated having lost its power at the cross.
2. The Plaintiff, following a previous order (Matthew 6:24) of the Supreme Judge of the Highest Court of the Kingdom of God, intends to pledge their allegiance to only one master – Jesus Christ.
3. The Plaintiff renounces any and all right, claim or interest in any possession jointly acquired with the Defendant during this partnership gained by means of avarice, greed, covetousness, parsimony, self-reliance and false philanthropy\*\*, and that Plaintiff is entitled to have sole right, claim, and interest, in and to all the gifts, possessions, treasures and inheritance from Plaintiff's Father, and the

Defendant is to be and forever barred from the title, control, or use of any such gifts, possessions, treasures or inheritance.

4. The Plaintiff seeks the full release of wealth, gifts, treasures, possessions that have been held back from the kingdom of God.
5. The Plaintiff decrees that all beneficiaries of this partnership who have been impoverished or have had viability for only brief periods and were either destroyed by the Defendant or were so infected by sickness, imprisonment or poverty attributed to the Defendant's actions that no life remained in them, will have full restitution of their losses up to seven times that which was lost or stolen.
6. The Plaintiff repudiates any and all joint claims with the Defendant, and requests this court to sever all relationships with the Defendant of any nature, however and whenever such occurred, and seeks enforcement by this Court of Plaintiff's desire to be in covenant with none other than the Plaintiff's Father.
7. The Plaintiff also seeks an everlasting restraining order against the Defendant so as to keep the Defendant away from all persons or property and all future generations belonging to the Plaintiff.

## **THE JUDGEMENT**

WHEREFORE, this Court being fully advised in the evidence does find for the Plaintiff and against the Defendant in all matters material to the Plaintiff's Petition of Dissolution, and does by this decree grant the Plaintiff Dissolution of Partnership and all requests set forth above.

That being the Order of this Court, from and after this date, so shall it be.

\*\* There are at least five manifestations or spirits that flow from the Spirit of Mammon.

The spirit of greed—extensive desire for material possessions. We falsely believe that are well being is defined by our wealth. 1 Timothy 6:10—"For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows."

The spirit of covetousness—a desire for specific things that are forbidden. It heads to idolatry. Colossians 3:5—"Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry." People in idolatry can not prosper—2 Chronicles 24:18-20—"Therefore they left the house of the LORD God of their fathers, and served wooden images and idols; and wrath came upon Judah and Jerusalem because of their trespass. Yet He sent prophets to them, to bring them back to the LORD; and they testified against them, but they would not listen. Then the Spirit of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, who stood above the people, and said to them, "Thus says God:'Why do you transgress the commandments of the LORD, so that you cannot prosper? Because you have forsaken the LORD, He also has forsaken you.'"

The spirit of parsimony—this is not mentioned in the Scriptures but is defined as stinginess. Rich people are poor because they can't let go. America is defined as a "culture of clutter" and hoarding.

The spirit of self-reliance—having great possessions can convince us that we don't need God anymore. A false word—"God will help those who help themselves." Deuteronomy 8:18 is a powerful word—"And you shall remember the LORD your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day."

The spirit of false philanthropy – the systems of the world and demonic principalities cause a false perception of generosity but it is driven not by a spirit of giving but by manipulation, control and domination of the treasures of the world. It brings the recipients into a false security as well as a deception that their needs are being met by God rather than the Spirit of Mammon.
